

Agency in Charge of Standardization

In case where a government agency is already carrying out any matter in connection with standardization in any specific field, the Council shall designate the aforementioned government agency to be the Agency in charge of standardization in the specific field and to have the same duties and power as the Committee under section 13. Resolution of the NSC meeting dated 1 June B.E. 2553 assigned three accreditation bodies to be an agency in charge of standardization according with the National Standardization Act B.E. 2551 section 30 as follows Department of Public Health, Department of Science Service and National Bureau of Agricultural and Food Standards.

Appointment of the National GLP Compliance Monitoring Authority

Reference is made to the Resolution of the National Standardization Council (NSC) Meeting dated 27 August B.E. 2561.

In accordance to the National Standardization Council Act B.E. 2551, Section 30, the Department of Medical Sciences has been appointed to be the National Good Laboratory Practice (GLP) Compliance Monitoring Authority for inspecting and monitoring the compliance of the Test Facilities to the principles of OECD GLP covering the scope of the followings: pharmaceuticals, pesticides, cosmetic products, veterinary drugs, food additives, feed additives, industrial chemicals , and other (to be added and amended).
